We will take tires, but there will be a disposal fee.

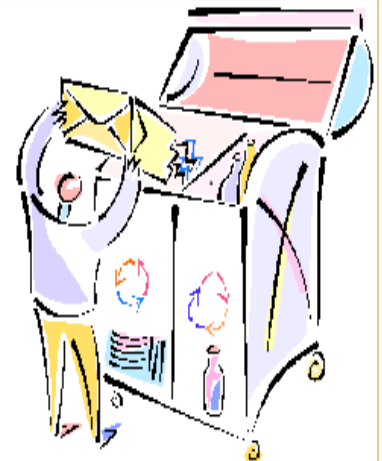
Refrigerators and freezers must have doors removed.

HUNTINGDON REGIONAL FIRE & RESCUE

With Spring around the corner, we turn our plans to spring clean-up. For many this means burning debris left from fall and winter. Your fire department urges you to burn responsibly. This means continuously supervising any fire. Ensure all combustible materials are kept clear of any possible flying embers. Be aware of rapidly changing wind conditions. Have a garden hose available, if possible, and any tools that could help if a fire starts to spread. Please do not hesitate to call 911 for help. Time is important to prevent further spread of the fire.

If you are burning wood it is important to check and clean your chimney frequently as the big temperature swings cause us to burn the wood burner a little less hot allowing the creosote buildup rapidly.

A Word from your Supervisors

We don't want to raise your Sewer rates, but the Township must pay the Sewer Authority, by the gallon, for processing the flow of sewage through the system.

We have monitored the sewage flow daily and find that on rainy days or high snow melt days, the flow increases substantially. Ours is a closed system so it is **NOT** just natural runoff.

DO NOT attempt to connect **DOWNSPOUTS OR SUMP PUMPS** to your sewer system. If they have been attached in the past, make appropriate changes to your system.
