## WELCOME BACK, STEVE



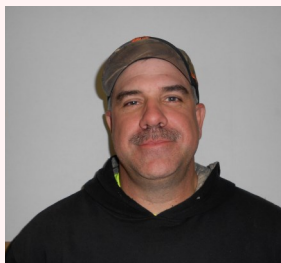
Oneida Township is pleased to have Stephen Magill back as a Supervisor of the Township. He had been a Supervisor for 16 years when he decided to spend more time with his family.


Chris started working for us in February 2018 and is looking forward to learning how the job differs with each of the seasons. Welcome Aboard, Chris!
