## ONEIDA TOWNSHIP NUISANCE ORDINANCE

Oneida Township has passed a nuisance ordinance which deals with the following issues:

- CESSPOOLS:** Failed systems or open drains prejudicial to public health.
- LIGHTS:** No lights, incandescent, strobe, sodium or mercury vapor, shall spot, flood or otherwise shine as to be an impediment to traffic or another's private property.
- OBSTRUCTING STREETS:** For any matter to remain on the street or gutter in front of a residence for more than 24 hours except by special permission from the Supervisors.
- DEPOSITING IN STREETS/STREAMS, ECT.:** Anything thrown or deposited in any road, alley, waterway or gutter.
- NAUSEOUS DRAINING ETC.:** Any foul or nauseous liquids, washings or draining into gutters or roadways. Or to keep or collect any garbage, filth, grease, or putrid matter near an establishment or residence within the Township.
- GLASS:** Any broken, sharp or dangerous substances to be thrown onto Township roadways.
- ODOR:** The emission of any offensive or foul odor or substance except for normal agricultural activities.
- OBSTRUCTING STREET:** No placing of vehicles or other obstruction on or along the streets of the Township as to interfere with traffic, except for loading and unloading merchandise for a given amount of time.
- CONDITION OF PROPERTY:** No one shall keep their property in such condition as to be offensive and a nuisance to the neighborhood or create health risks.
- JUNK:** Junk is not to be stored on any premises unless specifically authorized by the Supervisors.
- JUNKED MOTOR VEHICLES:** Any motor vehicle which is no longer in actual use, unfit to be operated or discarded cannot be stored upon owner's property. It must have a current valid registration plate and inspection sticker.
- NUISANCES, GENERAL:** Any person committing or maintaining a nuisance as defined by Chapter 65 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes shall be subject to punishments provided therein.
