

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING
FEBRUARY 3, 2021 7:30 PM
ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

PRESENT: John Skipper, James Ferrenberg, Stephen Magill, Henry Strong, Doris Hayden

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Magill motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month. It was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Some dead trees were cleared away from the roadway, snowplowing and a lot of antiskid was put down.

OLD BUSINESS: Clean-Up Days has been confirmed with Hollenbaugh's for April 30 and May 1, 2021.

The Supervisors were updated as to the status of acquiring a webpage for the township. As soon as PSATS's receives our payment, they will start the process.

NEW BUSINESS: The County Commissioners have decided that the recycling bins that are contracted through Park's Garbage Service are too expensive to maintain. They have asked the various townships where the bins are located if they are willing to take over the cost. We received a call from the Recycling Office saying it would be \$3250/year.

Due to the cost and the fact that too much of what is dropped off is NOT recyclable the Supervisors decided they would NOT continue with the program. Mr. Skipper motioned to discontinue with the recycling program and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

We have received "Thank you" from The Huntingdon County Library and the Huntingdon County Humane Society for our 2021 Contributions.

The Supervisors were given a report from the Water and Sewer Authority Meeting last month.

The Supervisors agreed that we had no road projects to submit to PSATS for their Safety Award.

The Western Pennsylvania Conservancy is interested in updating the Juniata Watershed Management Plan. They have asked municipalities to support this with a Resolution and Support letter. Mr. Skipper motioned to approve supporting the Juniata Watershed Management Update with **Resolution 2021-01** and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

Mr. Magill motioned to approve paying one third, our portion, of the 2021 tax program used by our Tax Collector, Lindsay Honn. It was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Ferrenberg and seconded by Mr. Magill.
