MAJOR ROAD WORK COMPLETED

IN ONEIDA TERRACE

Back in November of 2017 there was an article in the Newsletter about road work being done in Oneida Township. One of those projects was Frazier Crest in Oneida Terrace. We are finally able to report the completion of that project. We did not receive the PIB loan from PennDot until June of last year. We received the lowest bid from Sight and Stream, LLC to do the work in 2018 but they were unable to start it because the weather last year was so rainy, very little construction work was done. Our annual PennDot project for last year was Ridgeview Road. This project also had to be held over until this year because of the weather. So now, in 2019, we can report that these projects were finally completed in June. Frazier Crest was entirely rebuilt to allow better drainage of the road surface in heavy rains. Oneida Township was also able to obtain funds from Dirt and Gravel Roads to help pay the cost of this construction.

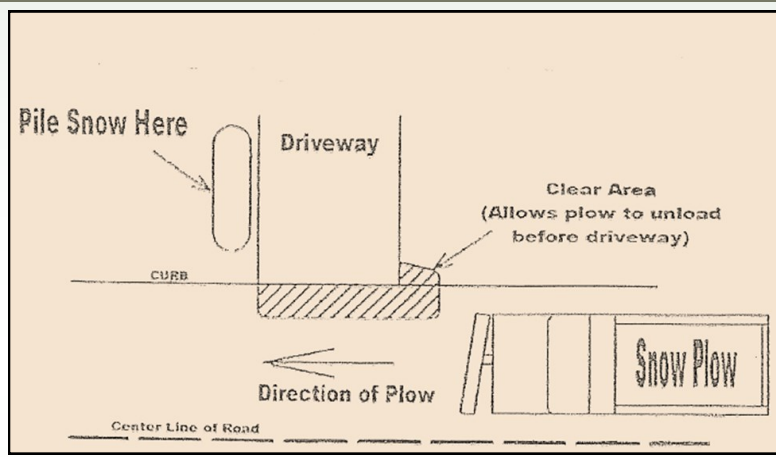

HOW TO PLOW YOUR DRIVEWAYS

Here's a better way to plow your driveway to keep the snow plows from plowing you back in after you have plowed your driveway.

As you look at this diagram if you clear the area to the right of your driveway, the snow plow then has a place to put the snow before it reaches the driveway. It would keep the snow from being dumped back into the driveway.

You are not allowed to plow the snow from your property into the road area. It is better to have a place to the side of the driveway to put the snow from off your driveway.

Please keep in mind that the plow trucks are doing the best they can to plow everyone out within a timely manner. Be sure your vehicles are not in the way of the plows. Keeping the roadway clear is a key factor in getting the job done quickly and efficiently.
