

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

APRIL 7, 2021 7:30 PM

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

PRESENT: John Skipper, James Ferrenberg, Stephen Magill, Henry Strong, Chris Carper, Roz Cunningham, Preston Raffensberger, Jim Swope, Doris Hayden

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: Ms. Cunningham questioned the Supervisors on why the Recycling Bins will no longer be available in the Township.

Mr. Raffensberger and Mr. Swope explained why HRF&R no longer wanted to pay for the phone located in the Hall. It was determined that it would cost the Township much less to pay for the phone service themselves. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the Township adding the cost of the phone including long distance to our current phone bill. Mr. Magill seconded the motion.

Mr. Raffensberger and Mr. Swope also told the Supervisors that it costs them \$50 to have the hall cleaned. Our current rental fee for using the Hall is \$40. Mr. Skipper motioned to approve increasing the fee for Township residents to \$60 and \$100 for Non-residents, to include the use of the kitchen, but not the stoves. It was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg. It was agreed that a new rental contract would be written up to reflect these changes.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong gave a brief report on the financial statements. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mixed the last of the antiskid for this year and cleaned up what was already on the road as well as downed trees and debris.

OLD BUSINESS: The Supervisors acknowledge the thank you letter received from the Arts Council for our annual donation.

Mr. Ferrenberg stated that he's waiting for people to get back to him about guard rails, before determining what we can do for the road project this year.

The Supervisors agreed to put one ad in the paper this year since we have it on the outdoor sign and also in the newsletter and the on the webpage.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Strong gave a detailed report on what we could do with the stimulus money from what we've been told by PSATS. There will be more specific information coming closer to the time the money is actually to be given out. At this time, we would be allowed to use it for anything associated with our sewer system, i.e., grinder pumps, cores or even a new truck that would be used to repair sewer lines. We can use it for loss of revenue as in EIT and Liquid Fuels Funds. We cannot use it for the PIB loan or road work.

The Supervisors did agree to add the Hall's phone to our current phone bill.
The Supervisors were all give new Second Class Township Code Books. The old ones are to be destroyed.

A pamphlet on the annual PSATS report was circulated among the Supervisors for their perusal.

Mr. Magill reminded the Supervisors that there will be a meeting at the Smithfield Fire on June 22 on Road work. Meal will be included.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.
