

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

JULY 7, 2021 7:30 PM

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

OPENING OF BID PACKETS:

New Enterprise Stone & Lime, Company, Inc.: \$48,691.95

New Enterprise Stone & Lime, Co., Inc. was the only bid received for this project. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to accept this bid for the 2021 Road Project on Loveland Drive and Warriors Path. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong gave a brief report on the financial status of the township. A motion to accept the minutes and financial reports from last month was made by Mr. Ferrenberg and seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: A lot of mowing and clearing of culverts was done this past month.

OLD BUSINESS: The guard rail was installed on Kyper Road. Mr. John Pecze will be here to inspect the work July 15. The Supervisors agreed to keep the remaining good guard rail for another job possibly next year. The bad guard rail will be sold for scrap.

Mr. Ferrenberg mentioned someone who might be interested in the Building Code Officer position. That will be followed up.

NEW BUSINESS: After we receive this year's portion of the ARPA money from the State, it will come into the General Fund, at which time it will need to be moved to its own account. Mr. Strong recommended a Kish account with himself and Mr. Skipper as signatories on the account. Any interest earned would be the Township's. Mr. Magill motioned to approve the account and it was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

Mr. Ferrenberg mentioned that we could obtain "butterfly" inserts for \$6 each from Chemung to put on the guard rail. A motion was made by Mr. Ferrenberg to purchase a box of 100 from Chemung and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

Mr. Strong asked the Supervisors about his vacation, and was assured by the Supervisors that his vacation time would be covered by salary for any time off.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Ferrenberg and seconded by Mr. Magill.
