

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

JUNE 2, 2021 7:30 PM

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to accept the minutes and financial report from last month. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: One Grinder pump needed repair, downed trees, roadside mowing as well as mowing around the municipal grounds.

OLD BUSINESS: The Supervisors agreed to run an ad in the newspaper for a Code Enforcement Officer. It will also be put on the website.

NEW BUSINESS: The Supervisors were given three quotes for the guard rail work to be done:

US Municipal:	Does not do guard rail work
Green Acres:	\$31,280.00
Chemung:	\$16,386.00

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to accept Chemung's bid of \$16,386.00. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

The Supervisors agreed to put up a "Hidden Driveway" sign on Cold Springs Road, near Dunningham Lane. Changing the speed limit is done by PennDot since it is a state road. PennDot will be called to ask that this be done.

The Roof Maintenance report was reviewed by the Supervisors. There were budgetary quotes for the cost of replacing 3 sections of the roof. There is a 15-year warranty on 2 sections of the roof, which is good until next year. The 3rd section needs to be painted, need to know if this can be done ourselves.

Our contract with CapTax for EIT collection is up this year, the Tax Committee is negotiating for a new contract.

Mr. Magill motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.
