OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong reported on uses for the COVID-19 money we are to get this summer. Possible uses would include making up for losses in EIT earnings and Liquid Fuels monies, also sewer repairs and upgrades. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Skipper.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: They have been removing tree limbs and branches from the roadways, mowing, cleaning culverts, and mulching.

OLD BUSINESS: The Supervisors signed Thank you letters to: John & Chris Shuck, Pat & Connie Elliott and Nan Stewart for their contributions to Clean-Up Days.

Mr. John Pecze will be here May 12, 2021 along with Mr. John Shuck to go over using used guard rail for the Road Project this year.

The Supervisors are looking into hiring a new Building Code Officer due to the resignation of Mr. Bob Greene.

NEW BUSINESS: The Supervisors tabled for now whether or not to transfer cell phone service over to Comcast.

The Supervisors have agreed to renew the cable franchise agreement with Comcast. The motion to approve the agreement with Comcast was made by Mr. Skipper and seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

Mr. Ray Myers sent in the report from last month's Water and Sewer Authority meeting.

Motion to approve **Resolution 2021-03** delegating Ms. Julie Johns as Oneida Township's representative at the Tax Collectors Committee meeting to determine who collects EIT monies was made by Mr. Skipper and seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg. The agreement with Cap Tax expires this year and the meeting to approve who will do it will be held May 13, 2021.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Ferrenberg and seconded by Mr. Skipper.
