OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong noted that the Foreign Fire Check has been deposited but not disbursed yet, leading to a larger income than there actually is. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

Mr. Skipper motioned to approve printing the November 2021 Newsletter and it was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

Mr. Skipper motioned to approve a \$8000 contribution to the Huntingdon Regional Fire & Rescue for 2021. It was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

Mr. Ferrenberg reported that since the cost of new grinder pumps will be going up soon, he ordered 4 new ones to have on hand.

Mr. Magill discussed having portable radios and will look into what it will cost.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.
