

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING
SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 7:30 PM
ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

PRESENT: John Skipper, James Ferrenberg, Stephen Magill, Henry Strong, Chris Carper, Doris Hayden

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong reported that a CD was due this month and he will roll it over, since we have another due in January 2022. He will begin working on the Budget for 2022 this month. A motion to approve the minutes and financial report from last month was made by Mr. Ferrenberg and seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mowing, weeding, removing brush and downed trees, and clearing culverts were all done. The Liquid Fuels project will begin this week on Loveland Drive and Warriors Lane.

OLD BUSINESS: A contract with Cap Tax for 5 years to collect EIT was agreed upon at a rate of 1.75%.

Mr. Edward Habbershon has been hired part-time as Oneida Township's Code Enforcement Officer. A motion was made by Mr. Ferrenberg to hire Mr. Edward Habbershon and it was seconded by Mr. Skipper.

He has been given all the information on the Trailer to be moved to a property on Route 26 and is to contact Mr. Nicholas Newfield about how to proceed.

NEW BUSINESS: Tire collection for Huntingdon County will be held September 18, 2021 in the morning at the Fairgrounds.

Keller report on Wike Road for 2021 was given to the Supervisors.

The Supervisors reviewed **Resolution 2021-06**. It allows for the transfer of ARPA funds to the General Fund to replace lost tax revenue. A motion to approve the Resolution was made by Mr. Ferrenberg and seconded by Mr. Magill.

The 2020 Census shows a decrease in population in Oneida Township from 1077 to 1021.

The Supervisors agreed to change the November meeting to November 10, 2021.

An Executive Session on Personnel matters followed.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.
