OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong felt it would be prudent to use the Sewer Account for added money rather than pull more money from CDs since the interest rates are going back up. Also, it's not the time to make large purchases. The ARPA funds have been accounted for and the report for Treasury has been submitted. We are due to receive the rest of the ARPA money in the next few weeks. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Ray Myers sent minutes from the Water and Sewer meeting last month.
