

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

JUNE 2, 2022 7:30 PM

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: Mr. Skipper welcomed Mr. Thompson who is here on behalf of the Daily News.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong cautioned the Supervisors that we are still dealing with inflation issues, especially in regards to fuel consumption. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Tis the season for mowing. A couple of grinder pumps were worked on. Mr. Ferrenberg reported that there are 4-5 grinder pumps on hand.

OLD BUSINESS: Mr. Doug Gummo has the citation for Mr. Mark Stewart at this point.

We have received the approval from DEP for Mr. Robert Holmes' septic system.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve **Ironwood Drive** as a new road name for the Perow Subdivision. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

Mr. Skipper motioned to approve **Resolution 2022-04** that will increase the Tax Collector's Fees for Tax Certification and Duplicate Bill Fees from \$5 and \$2.50 respectively to \$10 for both. It was seconded by Mr. Magill. It is noted that these increases will not go into effect until the following term of the Tax Collector.

The Supervisors agreed to table the approval of the Conese subdivision until more information can be gathered.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.
