ROAD PROJECTS IN ONEIDA TOWSHIP FOR 2017

There have been, and are, several road projects Oneida Township has been working on for the past several years. Back in 2013 when we had the storm in March that took out part of Kyper Road we received money from PEMA/FEMA to repair it and Blair Road as well. As you know, Kyper Road was repaired. Blair Road needed permitting from DEP before it could be repaired because we wanted to put in a culvert to keep the road from flooding out. We finally received the permit this past spring and the culvert was put into place. Now we are able to finish Blair Road with DSA (Driving Surface Aggregate) for which we will be reimbursed from a Dirt and Gravel grant from Soil Conservation. Also on the agenda is repairing Frazier Crest for which we applied for a loan from PennDot known as a PIB loan. We received word in June that DECD, the Department of Economic and Community Development, which oversees township finances, gave the go ahead for the loan, which then went to PennDot for final review and approval. We are still waiting for that to be confirmed. Finally, we are repaving Prendergast Extension with Liquid Fuels money, that is money we receive from Penn-Dot to maintain our roads. This is an annual payment that comes from the gas taxes paid at the pump. The amount we received this year was \$52,077.74. New Enterprise Stone and Lime Company, Inc. will be doing the work on Prendergast Extension for \$43,829.70.
