OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mr. Magill wanted to thank the Road Crew for replacing the pipe at the cemetery. Roadside mowing was done one last time and the mower was removed from the tractor, getting ready for winter weather.

OLD BUSINESS: There is no news on the Stewart property.

NEW BUSINESS: The maintenance building Westminster Woods is building that partly falls on Oneida land, will be treated as land development and is in the hands of Mr. Tom Levine.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve **Resolution 2022-05** dealing with the waiver of fees on certain real estate taxes. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

Mr. Magill motioned to approve the November 2022 newsletter and it was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

Mr. Magill motioned to approve Huntingdon Regional Fire & Rescue as the sole recipient of the Foreign Fire Money and it was seconded by Mr. Skipper. The amount approved is \$7031.28.

Mr. Skipper also motioned to approve the amount of \$8000 to be given as a contribution to the Huntingdon Regional Fire & Rescue. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

Estimated Liquid Fuels money for 2023 is \$49,716.88.

The second tranche from ARPA came in at \$55,125.08.

The Supervisors agreed to meet for the annual Budget Workshop at a date that suits Mr. Henry Strong, treasurer.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.
