

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

December 7, 2022 7:30 PM

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong gave a report on the Municipal Advantage accounts available at both First National and Kish Banks. Mr. Skipper motioned to approve utilizing Kish Bank for their Municipal Advantage account. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.
Mr. Magill motioned to approve the 2023 Budget for Oneida Township. It was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: As the Roadmaster was on vacation for the Month of November, Mr. Carper gave the report: Cleaned ditches and culverts, repaired damaged culvert on Blair Road, removed downed trees and treated roadways for ice.

OLD BUSINESS: Mr. Levine gave a brief overview of the work to be done for Westminster Woods. There will be a need for further discussion about sewer permitting since the sewer line runs through both Oneida Township and Huntingdon Borough. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the plans for Westminster Woods and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

The motioned to approve the plans for the Conese subdivision was made by Mr. Magill and seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

NEW BUSINESS: The Township has been asked to host a flagger program this coming summer. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the use of the hall for this class. It was seconded by Mr. Magill.

The township is already receiving requests for contributions from local groups. The Supervisors agreed to stay with the ones from past years. These include: HC Library, HC Arts Council, HC Humane Society and the HC Ambulance Authority. Motion to approve these four contributions at \$250 each was made by Mr. Ferrenberg and seconded by Mr. Magill. These will be made in 2023.

The Supervisors were reminded that the January meeting will be January 3, 2023 @ 7 pm.
