Oneida Township Census Statistics from 2000 and 2020

Note: The information in the beginning of this article is according to the 2000 Census. An update from the 2020 Census is given at the end of the article.

Oneida Township has a total area of 17.57 square miles, with 17.54 square miles of land and .03 square miles is water.

According to the **Census of 2000**, Oneida Township had 1129 people, 511 housing units, 466 households and 358 families living in the Township with a population density of 64.1 people per square mile.

The racial makeup of the township was 98.32% white, .71% African-American, .09% Native American, .08% Asian, and .09% two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were .09% of the population.

There were 466 households, 28.8% had children under the age of 18.

66.3% were married living together, 7.5% were a female householder with no husband present, and 23% were non families.

Individuals made up 19.7% of households and 7.9% had someone over 65 of age living alone.

The average size of households in Oneida Township was 2.42 people and the average family size was 2.78 people.

The Township population ranged from 22.1% under the age of 18, 5% ; between 18-24, 26.4% ; between 25-44, 29.2% ; between 45-64; and 17.4% for 65 and older.

Median age was 44 years.

For every 100 females, there were 98.1 males and for every 100 females over 18, there were 96.4 males.

Median income was \$41, 438, with a median income per family \$45,284.

Males had a median income of \$37,614 and females had a median income of \$25,208.

Per capital income for the Township was \$19,729.

Approximately 3.5% of families and 7.9% of the population were below the poverty line, including 14.5% of those under 18 years of age and 6.6% of those aged 65 and older.
