OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: Mr. Hull asked the Supervisors if they would be willing to approve a plan to improve parking along Old Hawn Road near the Donation Rocks. Mr. Hull is looking to obtain a grant to help pay costs and would appreciate the Supervisors' approval of the project. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve Mr. Hull's endeavor to improve the parking along Old Hawn Road. It was seconded by Mr. Skipper.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong reported to the Supervisors that a new account will be opened this month with Kish Bank that will take \$61,000 from Huntingdon Savings Bank and \$39,000 from the General Fund and put it into a higher interest-bearing account @ 4.39%. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the moving of funds to the new account and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mr. Carper reported that work was done to clear culverts, remove debris from the roadways and put up a couple of road signs.

OLD BUSINESS: Clean-Up Days has been scheduled with Hollenbaugh's Garbage and Recycling for April 28-29, 2023.

NEW BUSINESS: A report on the Water and Sewer Authority meeting from last month was presented to the Supervisors.

Thank you's were presented to the Supervisors from the Huntingdon Library and Huntingdon Humane Society for contributions given last month.

A short Executive Session followed. Payment for sewer on-call will remain the same and changes in phone service for the Roadmaster and Maintenance personnel will be initiated.

Mr. Magill motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.
