NEW BUSINESS: Ms. Lindsay Honn has asked the Supervisors to pay their share of a new computer program for taxes as was done in past years. Mr. Magill motioned to approve the payment and it was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.

The April 2023 Newsletter was approved for printing with a motion made by Mr. Magill and seconded by Mr. Skipper.

Mr. Tim Furlong did not attend the meeting.
