

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

AUGUST 2, 2023 7:30 PM

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

PRESENT: John Skipper, James Ferrenberg, Stephen Magill, Henry Strong, Chris Carper, Nick Newfield, Joe Thompson, Sarah Hayden

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong requested permission to move \$50,000 from the account at Huntingdon Savings Bank into a 3-month CD at Mid Penn Bank at a rate of 5.02%. Mr. Skipper motioned to give Mr. Strong this authority, and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

Mr. Skipper motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Magill.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mr. Carper reported that he completed the 2<sup>nd</sup> roadside mowing, cut brush, and cleaned up after storms this month. The dump truck was inspected and a recall was performed on the pickup truck at no cost. There was one PA one-call this month which was marked.

OLD BUSINESS: Mr. Skipper reported that he has heard complaints about the Stewart property and several others. Mr. Newfield recommended having the code enforcement officer contact the owners of any such properties before taking any other action.

Mr. Newfield reported that he had read another solar ordinance that was recently passed by another township. He thought it might be better suited for Oneida township. He stated that he will send it over for the supervisors to review.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Strong presented a spreadsheet on the sewer fund in regards to buying new grinder pumps. He recommended buying only 3 new grinder pumps at this time. Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to buy 3 new grinder pumps and Mr. Magill seconded the motion.

Mr. Ferrenberg reported that a resident had voiced a concern about changing/enforcing the speed limit. There was a short discussion. No action will be taken at this time.

Mrs. Hayden informed the supervisors that HA Thompson will be coming prior to next months meeting and that the County Planning Commission will be attending the September meeting to provide information on possible funding options.

Mr. Ferrenberg made a motion and Mr. Magill seconded to adjourn the meeting.
