

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

APRIL 3, 2024 7:30 PM

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

PRESENT: James Ferrenberg, John A. Los, John Skipper, Henry Strong, Chris Carper, Josh Crownover, Tim Furlong, Shelly Brown, Kelly Cunningham, Sarah Hayden

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: Mrs. Cunningham asked the supervisors if they had considered her proposal for adding dog barking to Oneida Township's Nuisance Ordinance. Mr. Skipper reported that he had discussed the matter with the township's solicitor and he felt that dog barking would not be something that was enforceable. Mr. Skipper said he was not in favor of amending the ordinance at this time. Mr. Ferrenberg and Mr. Los agreed. A small discussion followed involving other options for helping Mrs. Cunningham.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong stated that the township has two CD's coming due in the near future and he would recommend rolling them over unless the township has a monetary need for projects/expenses in the near future.

Mrs. Brown reported that the 2023 Audit was completed in February with no issues to report.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Skipper.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mr. Carper reported cleaning antiskid off roads, cutting down some dead trees along roads, and 2 sewer calls in March. He also said that he met with a Dirt and Gravel technician from the Huntingdon County Conservation District to discuss applying for a grant to help with a possible project at the end of Blair Road.

HRFR REPORT: Mr. Furlong reported 33 incidents handled in March and \$59,757.08 that went out in expenses including \$11,002.69 for equipment maintenance. They also reported having 2 new members from Oneida Township.

OLD BUSINESS: Mr. Skipper reported that everything is lined up for Clean-up days on April 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Ferrenberg reported that the paperwork for the proposed 2024 road project had been completed and would be advertised this month.

Mr. Skipper made a motion to apply for CDBG grant money to do repairs on the township building. Mr. Los seconded the motion.

Mr. Ferrenberg stated that the township's dump truck would need replaced soon.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Los.
