

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

MAY 1, 2024 7:30 PM

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

PRESENT: James Ferrenberg, John A. Los, John Skipper, Henry Strong, Chris Carper, James Grissinger, Tim Furlong, Joe Thompson, Sarah Hayden

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: Mr. Strong expressed his thanks to the supervisors and everyone who helped make Clean-up days 2024 a success. Mr. Skipper reported that 15 tires were collected during clean-up days and 5 roll off containers were filled. He also stated that he would like to thank everyone who helped over the 2-day period and those who made monetary and food donations.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong brought attention to the fact that Oneida Reserve Account made \$5,000 in interest in the last year. He stated that the money in the reserve account is available when needed and will be helpful if the township decides to replace the dump truck in the near future.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Los.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mr. Carper reported the signs that had gone missing from Gorsuch Road had been replaced, holes were patched with stones on Blair and Ridgeview roads. He also stated that the rear brakes were replaced on the dump truck, and the throttle cable was replaced on the lawn mower. There was also one sewer call in April.

HRFR REPORT: Mr. Grissinger reported 42 incidents handled in April, and \$500 profit from a booth at Mayfest. He did not have an expense report available yet. Mr. Grissinger asked for the townships help in accessing the 2 dry hydrants in the township. Mr. Skipper said he would contact the land owner and get approval to put some stones down.

OLD BUSINESS: Mr. Skipper gave his clean-up day report during Visitors Comments.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Los opened the road bids received for the 2024 road projects. Russell Standard Corporation bid \$79,752.11 to complete both proposed projects and Midland Asphalt Materials, Inc bid \$84,900.15 to complete both proposed projects. Mr. Ferrenberg made a motion to accept the bid from Russell Standard Corporation to complete both projects. Mr. Los seconded the motion.

Mr. Los motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Ferrenberg.
