

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MEETING

JUNE 5, 2024 7:30 PM

ONEIDA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING

PRESENT: James Ferrenberg, John Skipper, Henry Strong, Chris Carper, Sarah Hayden

OPENING: Mr. Skipper opened the meeting with the "Pledge of Allegiance".

VISITORS' COMMENTS: None.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS: Mr. Strong brought attention to the fact that interest rates on the townships investments are holding steady for the time being, resulting in \$2,000 interest accrued from the CD at Mid Penn Bank and \$6,000 interest accrued in the Oneida Reserve Account in the last year.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to approve the minutes and financial reports from last month and it was seconded by Mr. Skipper.

ROADMASTER'S REPORT: Mr. Carper reported doing roadside mowing and weed eating, one sewer call which resulted in a grinder pump being replaced, and PA1 call which was a New Utility Pole on Cold Springs Road. Mr. Carper stated that he and Mr. Ferrenberg will meet with landowners to finalize plans for the proposed grant work on Blair Road. Mr. Carper asked the supervisors for their permission to mow along Gorsuch Road for Henderson Township. The Supervisors agreed to it if Henderson Township pays for employee wages and fuel used. Mr. Carper also reported that Clint Corbin did not charge the township for disposal of the tires collected at Clean-Up Days. Mr. Skipper requested he be sent a thank you note for this donation.

HRFR REPORT: HRFR was unable to attend the meeting.

OLD BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS: The supervisors looked over the annual roof inspection report. There were no issues found.

Mr. Ferrenberg made a motion to pass Resolution 2024-1 which will increase auditor compensation to \$18/hr. Mr. Skipper seconded the motion.

The Huntingdon County Emergency Management Agency is holding a planning meeting to update the Huntingdon County Hazard Mitigation Plan on Monday June 24, 2024. Mr. Skipper and Mrs. Hayden agreed to attend the meeting.

Mr. Ferrenberg motioned to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Skipper.
